GET INVOLVED IN AN SU GROUP IN YOUR PRIMARY SCHOOL

What is an SU Group?

An SU Group can meet at lunchtime or after school. They create a place for young people to explore the Christian faith, bring friends, share ideas and enjoy time together.

The Scottish Government agree that SU Groups offer added value to the RME Curriculum through the exploration of the Bible and the life and teaching of Jesus.

• Reading the Bible - open Bibles and ask relevant question; WHO? WHAT? WHEN? WHY? HOW?

You can do this through...

- **Storytelling** share a Bible narrative through creative story telling techniques
- **Crafts** make a craft to illustrate the theme suggested by a Bible narrative
- **Games** make it fun by using themed social games which lead into a Bible passage
- **Drama** portray the events of a Bible story using props and involving role play
- Music kids worship songs can teach a lot from the Bible
- Lots More!

There are many resources you can use to help you, including our 2-year Programme - One BIG Story. Written for SU Groups in primary schools, it is free to download and uses all the above ingredients.

What can an SU Group look like?

When we asked some young people to define SU Groups, they said they can:

> Be safe places where all pupils are welcomed and respected; where Christian values are modelled; Be fun, memorable, exciting and age-appropriate; Have good, challenging, interactive Bible engagement; Have time where there is opportunity for prayer; Be well structured and led; the leader(s) recognising and using the talents of others;

Have a positive impact on the school, and be known amongst pupils;

Explore Christian faith and encourage one another on their journey;

Work cooperatively and openly with the leadership of the school.
