A key part of Bible Alive is Rhyme & Sign – a set of rhyming couplets accompanied by British Sign Language signs which recap the story of the Bible.

If you would like to take the story of the Bible into schools in your area, you might be interested in the next Bible Alive training course.





The closing date for applications is Monday 5th August. Videos will be sent to you in August to allow you to learn Rhyme & Sign ahead of the training course.

There are spaces on the course for a maximum of 8 people so early booking is advised. Priority will be given to people planning to use Bible Alive in schools.

The training course will include demonstrations and practice in various story telling techniques as well as advice on putting together a Bible Alive programme, planning lessons, and communicating effectively with schools.
