CREATING A JUNGLE QUIZ

Creating a jungle-themed quiz

There are many ways you could create a jungle-themed quiz. We offer the below as a few suggestions to get you started. You may wish to keep the same way all through the week or change it daily.

- 1. Have leaf shapes with different scores written on the back. Children choose a leaf to get their score.
- 2. Put rings of coloured cord around a tree, dividing it into ten segments. Each team could have a marker which moves up the tree, hooking onto the cords, as they gain more points. The team which reaches the top first wins.
- 3. Have a soft toy monkey sitting on top of a bucket. Children get three coconuts (balls) to throw at the monkey, trying to knock him off the bucket, getting points for each time they succeed.
- 4. Have a number of different 'vines' (cords) of different lengths under a bucket with one end of each sticking out. Each time a child answers correctly, they choose a vine and pull it out. Each team ties their 'vines' together and the team with the longest vine at the end wins.
- 5. Have a cut-out lion's head with a large open mouth. Children get three balls to 'feed the lion' and get points for each one which goes in.
